



LE ALTERNATIVE ALLA PERIFERIA DI SLAB-URBIA

Slab-urbia viene definita come la tipica periferia modernista costruita in tutto il continente nella seconda metà del secolo passato, dopo la seconda guerra mondiale. Differisce dal suburb Anglo-American per l'essere costruito con l'impiego di enormi lastre di conglomerato cementizio armato nella forma di stecche e torri dove sono costretti ad abitare fino a 6.000 persone, come nei casi del Corviale (Roma) e de La Courneuve (Paris). Slab-urbia rappresenta il più grande disastro urbanistico, sociale, economico e ambientale del secolo passato. Dopo le recenti sommosse nelle periferie francesi, tutti i paesi dell'Unione Europea stanno cercando di presentare alternative ispirate a un modello ambientale più umano e rispettoso delle tante differenti culture regionali.

Il workshop ha lo scopo di offrire a politici, decisori, amministratori pubblici e privati, imprenditori, tecnici e cittadini una serie di casi di studio relativi a interventi di successo in città europee basati sul nuovo modello di sviluppo di una comunità ecologica, compatta ed efficiente alla scala pedonale: il quartiere urbano integrato.

I casi di studio affrontano: la fondazione di una nuova città di 40.000 abitanti; la realizzazione di un nuovo centro urbano per un comune periferico di un'area metropolitana; l'ampliamento di una città media; il completamento urbano di aree degradate e la loro trasformazione in quartieri integrati.

THE ALTERNATIVES TO SLAB-URBIA

Slab-urbia is defined as the typical European modernist periphery built all over the continent in the second half of the past century, after world war II. It differs from the Anglo-American Sub-urbia for being built with huge concrete slabs in the form of bars and towers accommodating up to 6,000 people each, as in the case of Corviale (Rome) and La Courneuve (Paris). It corresponds to the major European social, economic and environmental disaster of the past century. After the recent riots in the French peripheries, all the EU countries are trying to fix the problem and present alternatives inspired by a more human-oriented development pattern respectful of the many different Regional cultures.

The workshop aims at offering politicians, decisors, administrators, developers, technicians and citizens a series of case-studies from successful interventions in European cities based upon the new ecological-sensitive concepts of compact and efficient walkable community: the mixed-use urban neighborhood.

Case-studies deal with: the planification and construction of a new town for 40,000 inhabitants; the construction of a new urban centre for a peripheral municipality in a metropolitan area; the extension to a medium-size city; urban infill in decaying areas and their transformation into mixed-use urban neighborhoods.
